

# NORTHERN COLORADO JUNIOR GOLF TOUR



## Team Info:

### Who:

Juniors who would like to participate in a competitive team format, qualifying weekly. This tour is a safe place for Juniors to get a feel for, and learn, what is required to play competitively.

### What:

Juniors compete in a qualifying round each Monday afternoon at Collindale Golf Club. They must sign up in the Golf Shop by 2:00 on the Sunday before. Pairings are made Sunday evening. The qualifying round tee times are on Mondays between 1:00 & 1:30 so Juniors need to be at the golf course to check in and be ready to play at 12:30 on Mondays. Those who make the cut on Monday will represent the Collindale Golf Club Team for play on Wednesdays.

There are nine opportunities to qualify throughout the season - so if you don't make the cut the first time, please keep trying! Just like the real tour, kids don't make it every week but we want them to have the experience that playing in the qualifying rounds bring.

Three kids will play in each of the 9 Hole divisions:

9 Hole Girls for 13 & Under & 9 Hole Boys for 13 & Under

Four kids will play in each of the 18 Hole divisions:

18 Hole Boys Ages 14 - 18 & 18 Hole Girls Ages 14 - 18

### Where & When:

Qualifying rounds are Mondays at Collindale Golf Club. Wednesday tournament play is at a different course each week. See attached flyer for courses & dates. Kids can jump into the mix any time throughout the season.

### Player Expectations:

#### Attire:

For qualifying rounds, we expect players to wear appropriate golf attire (collared shirts and nice shorts, no denim please).

Players making the cut will wear team uniforms. They are light blue collared shirts with the Collindale Golf Academy logo and can be purchased in the Golf Shop for \$18.74.

### Behavior:

1. Be punctual. Show up at the golf course and check into the golf shop at least ½ hour before the expected tee time. This allows time to hit a few practice balls and to familiarize oneself with where the first tee is, seeing the course lay out etc.
2. Use good manners on and off the course. Use language that is supportive to your fellow players and that would not offend anyone. Be respectful to everyone.
3. Use proper golf etiquette. Familiarize yourself with the basics by going online and reading about it, and by talking with the PGA Golf Professionals at Collindale.
4. Maintain a positive attitude throughout your round. Realize that not just each new hole, but each shot is a new opportunity. Look for what is going “right” in your round.
5. Please thank the host facility’s Golf Shop staff when you are done playing.
6. Remember you are representing yourself and Collindale Golf Club - behave accordingly.

### **Parent Expectations:**

1. Assist your child with being to the golf course early so they are not hurrying or stressed. We want them to focus on being comfortable and ready for their round.
2. Talk with your child about what good manners look like – i.e. how to introduce themselves to their playing partners, using quiet voices on the course, and being respectful of other kids and their feelings.
3. Support your child in acquiring knowledge of what proper golf etiquette is and have them share with you what that looks like.
4. Talk with your child about how to handle frustrations on the course. Temper tantrums, profanity and throwing clubs, etc are not acceptable. Discuss what it looks like to keep a good attitude, and how to be a supportive playing partner. Brainstorm with them what the Golden Rule looks like on the golf course. How would THEY like to be treated?
5. Help your child know what an appropriate thank you looks like - what to say, how to shake hands, how to mention what may have been a positive highlight of the course that they enjoyed, etc. Talk with them about all the work that goes on behind the scenes by others so that they can enjoy their time on the course. Instill a sense of gratitude in them for what they are receiving.
6. Share with your child the importance of making a good impression in the world and how this is a great opportunity to practice that.
7. Support your child in this endeavor, no matter what the outcome. We want your child to have a positive experience realizing their own strengths and learning that playing in tour events is fun!

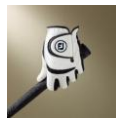

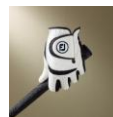
